SUBJECT: Agenda Item #4: Bolinas Lagoon Informational Brochure

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Chair to sign letter and incorporate it into the first Bolinas Lagoon information brochure.

DISCUSSION

Marin County Parks is working with One Tam and the Greater Farallones Association to develop printed materials about the Bolinas Lagoon restoration effort. The goal of these pamphlets is to inform and educate partners, community members, potential future funders, and other interested parties about the current and future status of the Bolinas Lagoon restoration projects. The first of these documents is an informational brochure that complements the 2008 *Bolinas Lagoon Ecosystem Restoration Project: Recommendations for Restoration and Management* (also known as the "Locally Preferred Plan"). The new brochure includes sections that describe the landscape, history, and partners that have worked to protect the lagoon. The brochure also highlights the goals and objectives of existing and future restoration projects.

The draft pamphlet includes an introductory letter from the Bolinas Lagoon Advisory Council (Advisory Council). The purpose of this letter is to encourage others to get involved in the process and support the protection and restoration of the lagoon.

At its October 27, 2017 meeting, the Advisory Council reviewed a draft letter, and requested a few changes to the letter and an opportunity to review the brochure containing the letter. Staff has incorporated into the letter the changes recommended by the Advisory Council, and has attached a draft version of the brochure.
