Re: 2018 Second Quarter Exemptions and Violations Summary

MESSAGE:

Exemptions

The following exemptions have been issued during the 2nd quarter of 2018

- 5/8/2018, Product Name: Acelepryn G. Although this product is on the Allowable Products List, this exemption was issued for the purpose of treating turf areas- which is restricted under the IPM policy. The active ingredient is Chlorantraniliprole, and is used for treating cut worms destroying the golf course greens. Given the complex conditions surrounding the management of turf at the golf course, including mowing heights less than 1/8", combined with moisture and fluctuating temperatures, the turf is highly susceptible to a variety of diseases and fungi. This treatment prevents significant damage to the golf course greens, which would otherwise render the course unusable.
- 5/9/2018, Product Name: Finalsan-O. This is an identical product (Finalsan, distributed by Engage) manufactured by same parent company (Neudorf) is already on our list. However, a different distributor (Certis) chose to acquire organic labeling. Because each distribution company has a different EPA number and product title, this is technically a new product with its own EPA number. This exemption was issued due to the public and departmental preference to use a brand that has been certified organic through OMRI.
- 6/4/2018, Product Name: Fresh Cab. This product is a preventative, scent-based rodent repellent using natural oils. It was previously on our Allowable Products List but was removed due to distribution/availability issues, and has now returned to the market under wide distribution. This exemption was issued through 2/4/19 at which point the product will be recommended for the 2019 Allowable Products List.

Violations

- There were no violations of the County IPM ordinance or policy during the first quarter of 2019.
