Re: 2019 Second Quarter Exemptions and Violations Summary

MESSAGE:

Exemptions

On May 3, 2019, an exemption was issued for PT Waspfreeze II for use in parks, picnic areas, and playground areas. Product is on IPM Allowed Products List. The exemption is requested for blanket use of the product with less than 4 days prior notice in emergencies and for public safety (ie. Someone has gotten stung; nest is in vicinity of people or high traffic areas) in areas where pesticide use is otherwise restricted by the IPM policy.

Violation

There was one of the County IPM ordinance or policy during the 2nd quarter of 2019. On May 13th, a contractor ATCO applied 1 oz of "Cimi Shield Protect" with active ingredient soybean oil (FIFRA 25b Minimum Risk) to a bed bug infestation at the Marin Health and Wellness Campus at 3240 Kerner Blvd in San Rafael. This product is not on our allowed products list.
