
VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROCESS



This infographic represents a general overview of Marin County Parks (MCP) vegetation management process. Sequence, timing, and duration of phases may differ from project to project.

VBMP: The Annual Vegetation Management Workplan outlines upcoming projects in 34 open space preserves to protect Marin's special places, rare species, and the Marin community from wildfire. The workplan is developed using the best management practices outlined in the Vegetation and Biodiversity Management Plan, a science-based, adaptive planning tool used to prioritize the most critical projects within the preserves. CEQA: The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) is a California environmental protection statute passed in 1970. For more information visit http://resources.ca.gov/ceqa/. There are different levels of CEQA required depending on the project.
