

Region 5 Road and Trail System Designation

The Marin County Open Space District is hosting a community workshop to solicit input on the formal road and trail designation of Region 5, shown on the map above.

This workshop will take place at the Embassy Suites San Rafael. It is an outcome of the Road and Trail Management Plan (RTMP), approved in December 2014.

In the workshop, Parks staff will review the following:

1. Potential trail designations for preserves in Region 5, which include Terra Linda/Sleepy Hollow, San Pedro Mountain, Santa Margarita Island, Santa Venetia Marsh, and Bald Hill.
2. Baseline scores and criteria that are part of the next phase of the public process, which allow members of the public to suggest changes to the proposed designated trail system.

3. The public proposal process, including application form and timelines, and how this will be integrated into the RTMP and yearly planning process.
4. Natural resource surveys and assessments of Region 5.
