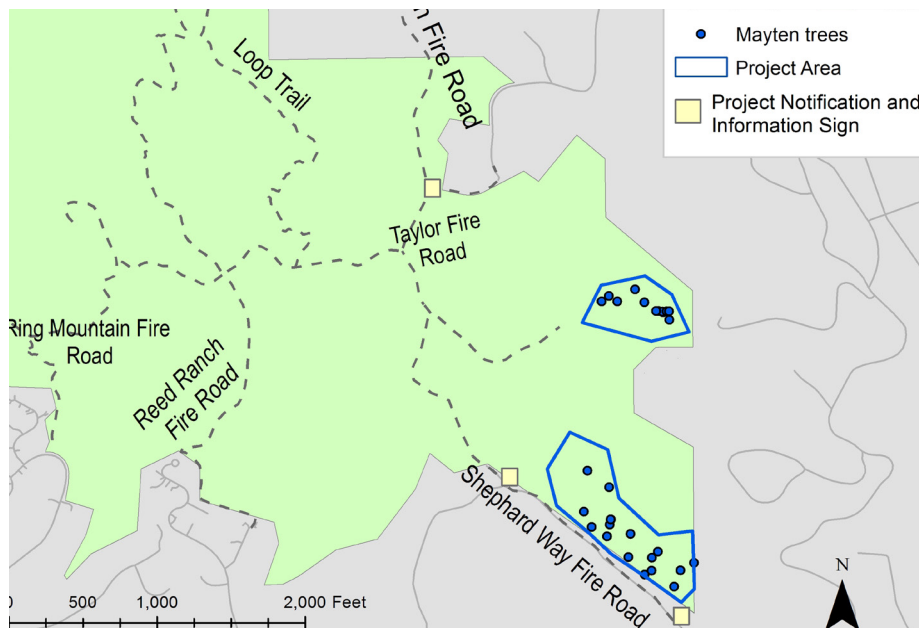


PROTECTING SPECIES
