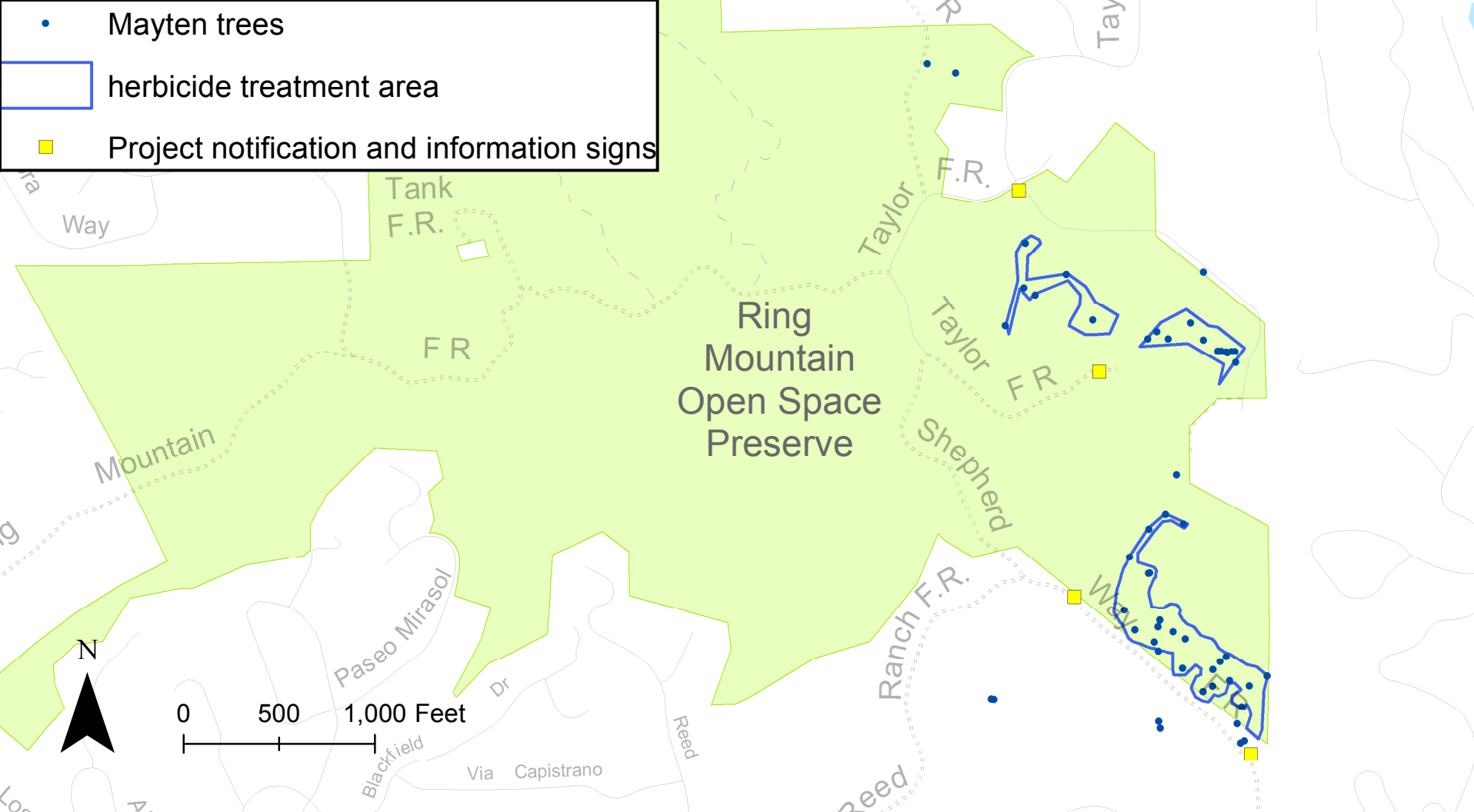

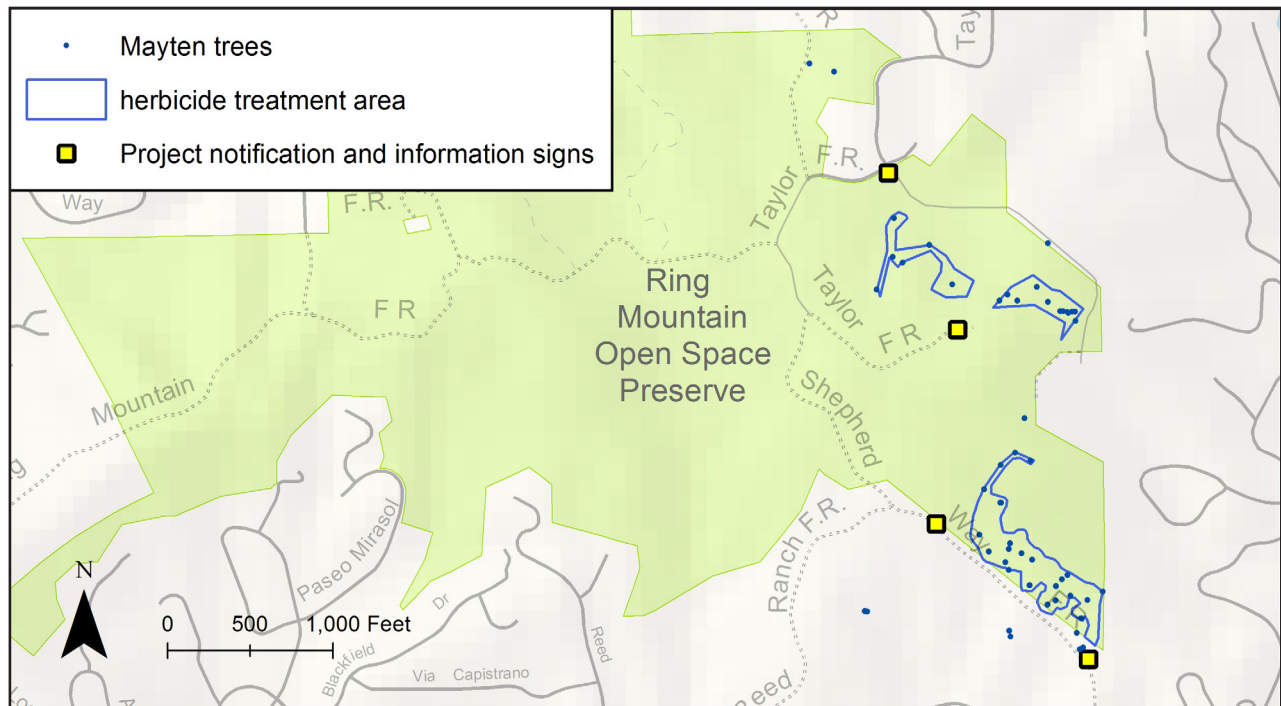

AUGUST 27 & 28, 2019



Chilean Mayten control has proven very difficult. As part of an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) program, we spent many years testing methods before finding a successful option. Staff carefully places a small amount of herbicide by hand into a cut on the tree trunk. Stopping the spread of Mayten helps to protect rare species like the Tiburon Mariposa Lilly.
