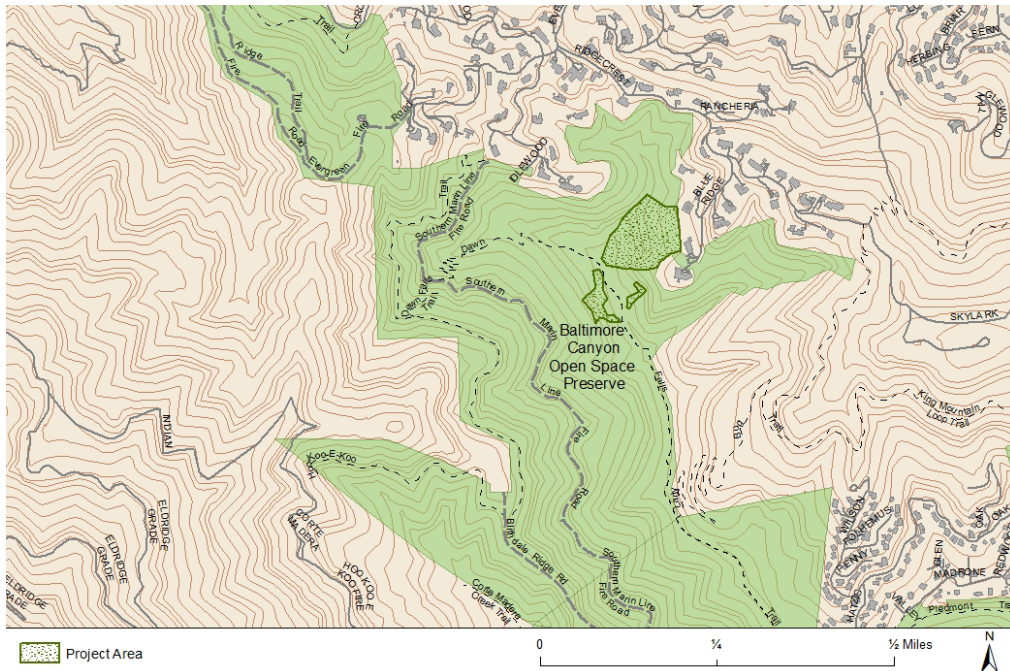

# MAYTEN REMOVAL

August 2021



The Marin County Open Space District and Marin County Fire are in partnership to implement a fire fuel reduction project that will help reduce fire risk to neighbors bordering Baltimore Canyon open space while also protecting habitat within the preserve.

In November 2020, Marin County Fire cut mature Mayten trees within the defensible space of neighboring homes, then piled and burnt the material. In August 2021,

Marin County Parks staff will carefully treat the cut stumps with a triclopyr-based herbicide to prevent regrowth.
