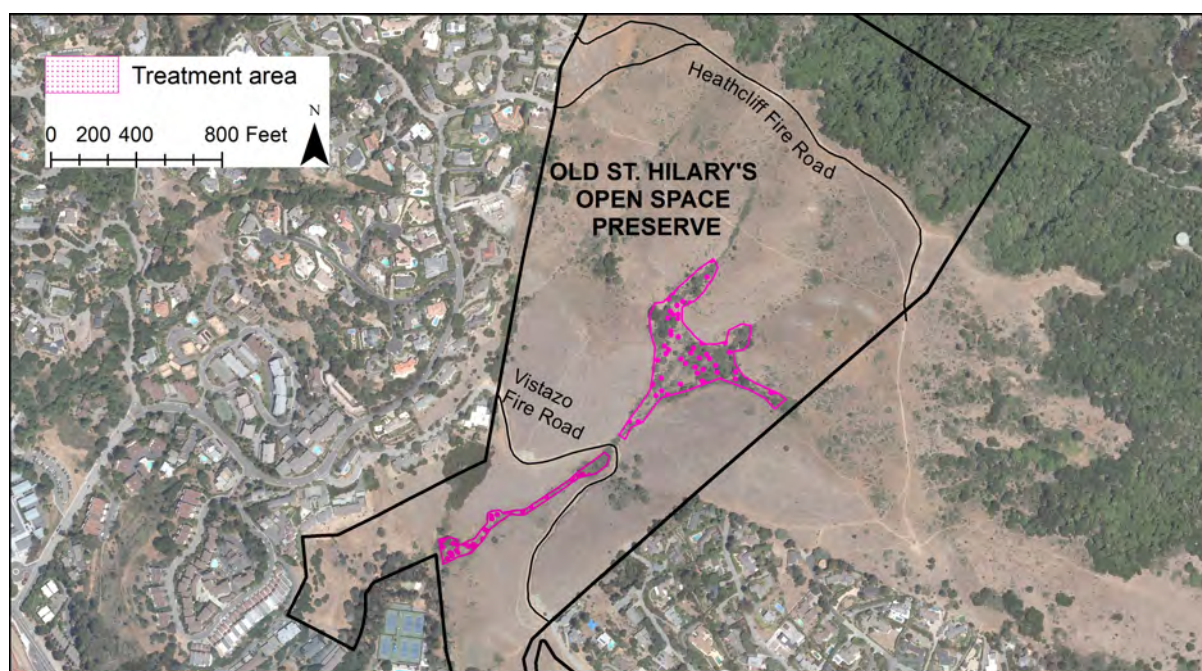

# PREVENTING INVASIVE WEEDS

October 28 - 31, 2024



Acacia, pyracantha, cotoneaster, cherry plum, and Himalayan blackberry are fast-growing invasive plants, which can spread quickly if left unmanaged.

Staff carefully places a small amount of herbicide onto each plant.

Stopping the spread of these invasive species helps to protect rare species and reduces fire risk.
